## Tools Required

Drill

5mm drill bit

Allen key set

Pencil - optional

Pozidrive screw driver


Pop rivet gun

4mm drill bit

Loctite

## Kit Contents

- 1 x Mast head float
- 2 x Metal brackets (port and starboard)
- 2 x Plastic cheek pads
- 4 x M6 x 12 machine screw
- 6 x 8 x 1/2 self tapper screw
- 6 x M5 small washer
- 8 x Monel Poprivets



## **Attaching the Masthead Float**

1. Attach the brackets to the masthead float using the four bolts provided.




The brackets are not the same and are labelled port and starboard. Make sure you use the correct bracket on each side.



Add a little Loctite to the threads of the screw.



2. Fix the cheeks to the brackets.




Position the assembly on the mast in the correct position and draw around the cheeks with a pencil.


Remove the cheeks from the bracket.

Using the pencil marks on the mast position the plastic cheeks.

Mark and drill the mast through the 5mm holes in the cheeks.



Fit the cheeks with 4 x pop rivets.



3. Make sure you have lined up the up the holes on the bracket, mounting plate and mast, run the 4mm drill bit through the holes, then attach the bracket using the 6 screws provided.



Add a little Loctite to the threads of the screws first.
